"HOW TO GET ON THE DEANS LIST"

The faculty approved a recommendation to increase the overall point average required for graduation at the Associate level from 1.8 to 2.0.

The faculty approved the recommendation that Southern Tech retain the English designation for honors graduates. The faculty further approved the following changes effective Fall, 1974:

For graduation 'With honor' the minimum average is 3.5. For graduation 'With high honor' the minimum average is 3.7. For graduation 'With highest honor' the minimum average is 3.9.

For graduation with honors a candidate must have a minimum of 60 hours in residence for the Associate Degree, and a minimum of 90 hours in residence for the Bachelor Degree.

Dean's List - Students (full-time) with a grade point average of 3.5 or greater for the current quarter and who are not subject to disciplinary action shall be on the Dean's List which is published each quarter by the Registrar's Office.
