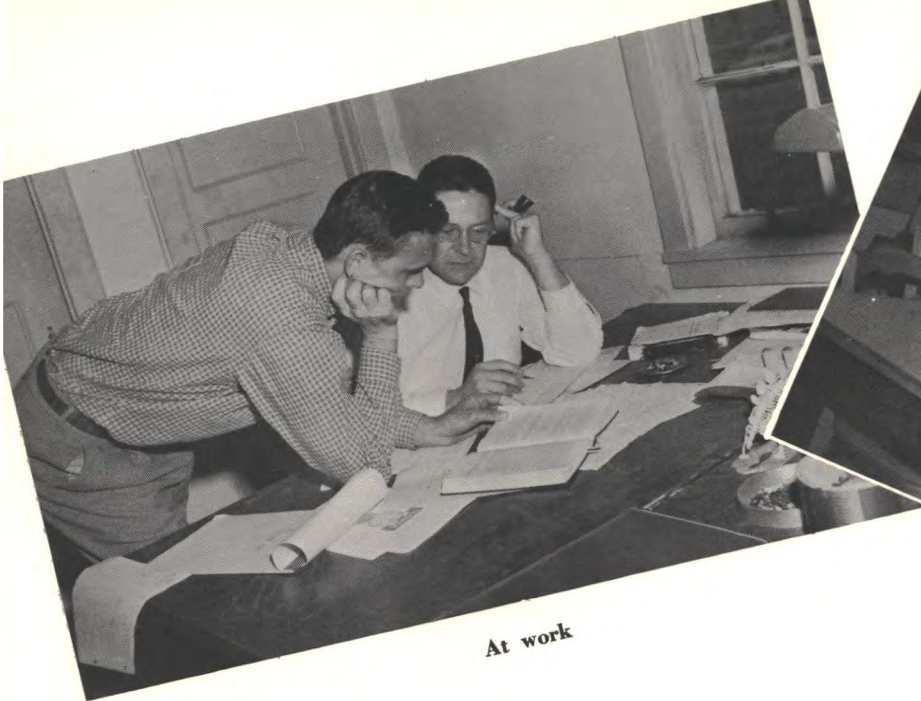
The Engineering Evening School, a unit of the Engineering Extension Division of Georgia Tech, offers a comprehensive training in Technical Institute work leading to the Associate in Science degree in a number of technical fields. Through the Evening School, these courses may be pursued on a part-time basis.

The Technical Institute work is identical in six areas offered at Southern Technical Institute: Building Construction Technology, Electrical Technology (Power Option), Electrical Technology (Electronics Option), Indus-

trial Technology, Industrial Technology (Management Option), and Mechanical Technology.

In addition to these curricula, refresher courses are offered in Physics, Mathematics, and English to prepare students to meet entrance requirements at university level.

Students who wish may take part of their training in the Evening School on the main campus of Georgia Tech and later transfer their credits to Southern Tech to complete their courses or vice-versa. The Evening School provides the working man an educational opportunity.
