24 This is the service of the families of the Gerthouites, to ferue, and for burdens.

25 Another Chalbearethe curtaines of the Tabernacle, and the Tabernacle of the Congregation; his covering, and the covering of the badgers skinnes that is about boon it, and the hanging for the doore of the Tabernacle of the Congregation:

26 And the hangings of the Court, and the hanging for the doore of the gate of the Court which is by the Tabernacle, and by the Altar round about, and their coeds, and all the instruments of their feruice, and all that is made for

them: so thall they ferue.

27 At the † appointment of Aaron and his sonnes, that be all the service of the somes of the Gershonites, in all their burdens, and in all their feruice: and yee thall appoint buto them in charge all their burdens.

28 This is the feruice of the families of the fonnes of Gerthon, in the Taber nacle of the Congregation: and their charge shall be binder the hand of Itha mar the sonne of Aaron the Priest.

29 CAs for the somes of Derari, thou halt number them after their families, by the house of their fathers:

30 From thirty yeeres old and bp ward, even buto fifty yeeres old halt thou number them, every one that ens treth in to the feruite, to doe the worke of the Labernacle of the Congrega

31 And this is the charge of their bur den, according to all their fernice, in the \* Exod. 26. Labernacle of the Congregation, \* the boards of the Tabernacle, and the barres thereof, and the pillars thereof,

and fockets thereof: 32 And the pillars of the Court

round about, and their sockets, and their pinnes, and their coards, with all their instruments, and with all their service : and by name ye shall reckon the instruments of the charge of their burden.

33 This is the service of the families of the somes of Derari, according to all their service in the Tabernacle of the Congregation, buder the hand of I thamar the sonne of Aaron the Priest.

34 C And Poles and Aaron, and

the chiefe of the Congregation, num beed the sommes of the Bohathites, af ter their families, and after the house of their fathers;

35 From thirtie peeres old and bps ward, euen bnto fiftie yeeres old, enery one that entreth in to the service, for the worke in the Labernacle of the Congregation.

36 And those that were numbed of them by their families, were two thoufand, seuen hundred and fiftie.

37 These were they that were num beed of the families of the Kohathites; all that might doe service in the Taber nade of the Congregation, which Poles and Aaron bid number, according to the Commandement of the Loup, by the hand of Moles.

38 And those that were numbed of the sonnes of Gerthon, throughout their families, and by the house of their fathers;

39 From thirtie yeeres old and bp ward, even buto fiftie yeeres old, every one that entreth in to the service, for the workein the Labernacle of the Congregation:

40 Even those that were numbred of them, throughout their families, by the houses of their fathers, were two thou fand, and fire hundred and thirty.

41 These are they that were num beed of the families of the sonnes of Gerthon, of all that might doe service in the Labernacle of the Congregatis on, whom Poles and Aaron did num ber, according to the Commandement of the Loud.

42 Cand those that were numbred of the families of the fonnes of Derari, throughout their families, by the house oftheirfathers:

43 From thirty yeeres old and bps ward, enen bnto fiftie peeres old, euery one that entreth in to the service, for the worke in the Labernacle of the Congregation:

44 Euen those that were numbred of them after their families, were three thousand and two hundred.

45 These be those that were num bred of the families of the sonnes of Merari, whom Moles and Aaron number according to the word of the LORD by the hand of Poles.

46 All those that were numbred of the Leuites, whom Poles and Aaron, and the chiefe of Israel numbred, after their families, and after the house of their fathers:

47 From thirty yeeres old and bp ward, even buto fifty peeres old, every one that came to doe the service of the ministerie, and the service of the burden in the Labernacle of the Congrega-

48 Euen those that were numbred of them, were eight thousand, and fine

hundred, and fourescore.

Ofrestitution.

49 According to the commandement of the LORD, they were numbred by the hand of Poles, enery one according to his feruice, and according to his burden: Thus were they numbred of him, as the Lou De commanded Poles.

Ad the Loup spake buto Poses, saying,
2 Commaund the children of Association they \* put out of the campe enery leper, and enery one that hath an

issue, and whosoever is defiled by the

Leuit. 21. \* DeaD:

[] Or, heane offering.

3 Both male and female thall ye put out, without the campe thall yee put them, that they defile not their campes in the middelt whereof I dwell.

4 And the children of Ilrael dio fo, and put them out, without the campe: as the Loup spake buto Poles, so did the children of Israel.

5 C And the Louve spake buto

Moles, laping,

6 Speake buto the children of IC rael, \* when a man oz woman thall commit any sinne that men commit, to doe a trespasse against the Loud, and that person be guiltie;

7 Then they thall confesse their sinne, which they have done: and hee thatt recompense his trespasse, \* with the principall thereof, and adde buto it the fifth part thereof, and give it buto him against whom he hath trespassed.

8 25ut if the man have no kiniman to recompense the trespasse buto, let the trespasse bee recompensed buto the LORD, euen to the Priest: belide the ramme of the atonement, whereby an atonement Mall be made for him.

9 And every | offering of all the

holy things of the children of Israel, which they bring buto the Priest, shall behis.

10 And enery mans halowed things thall be his: whatfoever any man giueth the Priest, it chall be \*his.

II Cand the Loup spake buto

wife goe alide, and commit a trespatte as gainst him;

15 Then that the man bring his wife buto the Prieft, and he thall bring her offering for her, the tenth part ofan & phah of barley meale: he thall power no ople bponit, noz put frankincense theres on foritis an offering of teloulie, an of fring of memoriall, bringing iniquitie to remembrance:

16 And the Priest thall bring her neere, and fet her befoze the LORD.

17 And the Prickt Chall take holy water in an earthen bestell, and of the dust that is in the flooze of the Tabers nacle the Priest thall take, and put it into the water:

18 And the Priest thall set the Woman before the LORD, and bucouer the womans head, and put the offering of memoriall in her hands, which is the Jeloulie offering: and the Priet thall have in his hand the bitter water that causeth the curse.

19 And the Priest Chall charge her by an oath, and say buto the woman, If no man haue iven with thee, and if thou haft not gone alide to bucleannelle with another in stead of thy husband, be thou free from this bitter Water that causeth the curle.
