


THE NAIA

The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) is a completely autonomous association which administers programs leading to national championships in 15 events for more than 500 fully-accredited four-year colleges and universities in all 50 states and Canada.

Established in 1940 as the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball the NAIB evolved from the institution of a "National Small College Basketball Tournament" which was inaugurated in 1937. In 1952, the NAIB expanded to include tennis, outdoor track and golf, and that year the organization was renamed the NAIA.

Since that time the NAIA has further enlarged to encompass football (two divisions were formed in 1970), cross country, baseball and swimming, which were added to the NAIA championship program in 1956, wrestling (1958), soccer (1959). gymnastics (1964). indoor track (1966), ice hockey (1968) and volleyball (1969)

With its national headquarters and staff located in Kansas City, MO, the NAIA is organized into 31 districts. The District Executive Committee is the governing body in each District with the District Chairman serving as the chief officer. Within the district an eligibility chairman and publicity chairman are appointed to handle various duties.

A major factor in the success of the NAIA program is the importance placed on "grass roots" organization, in which each district administers and organizes the programs of the schools within their own district. The districts are usually small enough in the number of schools involved that each individual institution has a major voice in the policy and decision-making process within that district. This procedure carries forward to the national level, where each of the 31 districts have an equal voice in national matters.

The NAIA clearly outlines its own responsibilities and those of its members, a sound athletic program, administered and controlled by those responsible for the administration of the college or university. The NAIA encourages a broad program of athletic pursuits in its member institutions and aims at uniformity and equity in policies and practices through its district and national championship events

Eligibility rules in the NAIA govern all competition in sports recognized by the NAIA, not just post-season competition. These rules must be adhered to by all NAIA member institutions, including those members holding dual affiliations with other associations NAIA member institutions must pay the annual membership dues and be in support of the policies of the Association.



THE TRADITION CONTINUES —

Last season George Perides, while coaching the Southern Tech Runnin' Hornets, reached a personal milestone, his 300th victory. It is with this kind of determination that the Runnin' Hornets enter into each basketball season. The Hornets have qualified for the NAIA District 25 playoffs each of the last 13 years. In the 1989 - 90 season, the team made it to the semifinals to be beaten by Georgia College, at Georgia College. A heartbreaking loss for a team that finished 24-8 for the season.

The Runnin' Hornets student assistant coach, former player Daren Holley, says that the fans are in for a surprise this year. With only three returning players, Maurice Charlton, Brad Durr, and Lamar Smith, the usually low scoring, strongly defensive team will come off the bench with surprising quickness, scoring more than the usual number of points. Perhaps this newly offensive team will catch our opponents, as well as our perennial fans off-quard.

This season's schedule features the Hornets hosting Talladega College, High Point College and Nova University in the Hornet Classic Tournament on November 30 and December 1. Then they will play, at home, always powerful conference rivals North Georgia College on Saturday, January 5, Kennesaw College on January 14, Georgia College on January 19 and Georgia Southwestern College on January 28.

Expect to see new players, Melvin Smith as a shooting guard, Jesse Usher as forward, Diego Davis playing point guard, Keith Willis as guard or forward, John Feltman as forward, and Don Berry as guard. The Runnin' Hornets also have their first freshman in four years in Greg Hill and Gary Beasely. Gary will be red-shirted this year, but Greg will play as guard or forward. Transfer Chris Pollard, playing center, is the Hornet's tallest player in a while, standing 6'8".

With all this new talent and a new look for our Hornet's, we hope to see you at many of our 17 home games and some of the remaining 13 away games. The Runnin' Hornets are your team, show your support!






