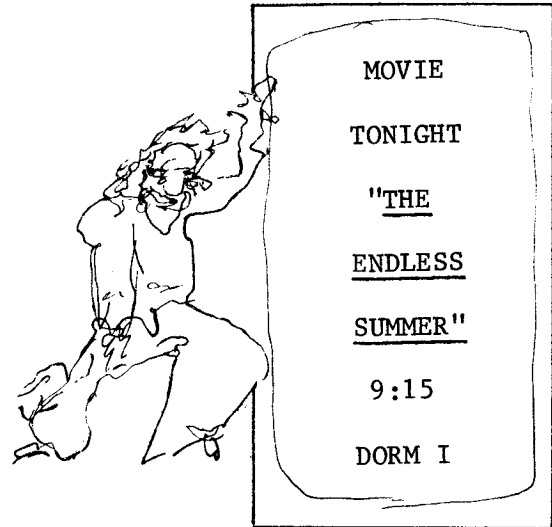


OVERPAYMENTSReturning VA checks:

Veterans receiving an overpayment are encouraged to cash the VA check and return the overpayment by certified check or personal check (thus providing yourself with a receipt). If you receive an overpayment (as a result of a withdrawal) and are returning to school the following quarter you may contact the VA and negotiate with them concerning your keeping the overpayment and having it deducted from your first check(s) upon your return to school.

R O T C

The two-year Army ROTC Program is open to both graduate and undergraduate students with two years remaining in school.

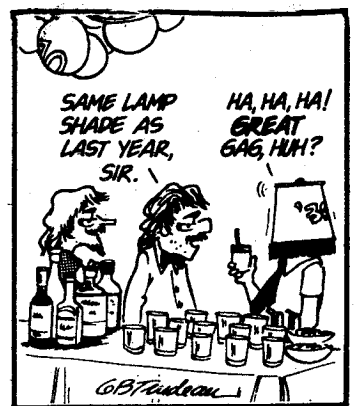
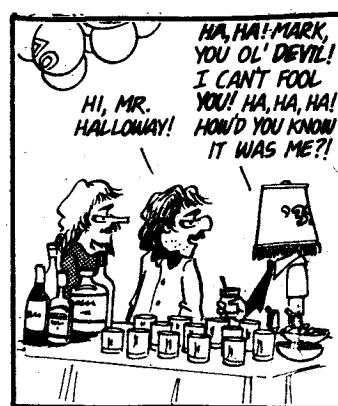
The student attends a six-week Army ROTC Basic Camp, drawing \$516.15 plus travel pay to and from Fort Knox, Kentucky, without obligating himself in any way.

In the fall quarter, following successful completion of camp, a student is eligible, but not required, to sign the Advanced Course ROTC contract and enroll in the Military Science Program. By signing the contract the student agrees to complete the Advanced Course ROTC program, accept a commission upon graduation, and serve from three months to two years active duty, depending on his request and the needs of the service at the time of commissioning. While enrolled in the Advanced Course, students are paid \$100 a month subsistence allowance, tax free.

Processing for the Two-year Army ROTC Program started on 11 Jan. 1975 at the Georgia Tech Army ROTC Headquarters and will continue until 30 March 1975.
