Several key issues have come before the SGA in recent weeks. These include: separation from Georgia Tech, continuance of the Community Dialogue Series, and the funding of athletics.

With a strong vote, the Student Gov't endorsed the position of separating from North Avenue. Several pro's and con's were debated, but the pro's for separation won a clear decision.

The SGA appropriated \$3000 for the purpose of continuing the Community Dialogue Series here at Southern Tech. The SGA felt the programs benefit the school identity.

The question of funding inter-collegiate athletics remains unsolved after two resolutions. One resolution would have set up a separate Athletic Fee, taking student control away from Athletics. The other resolution would appropriate the funding of the "Athletic Dept." on a matching funds basis. Neither proposal could gain enough support for a majority vote.

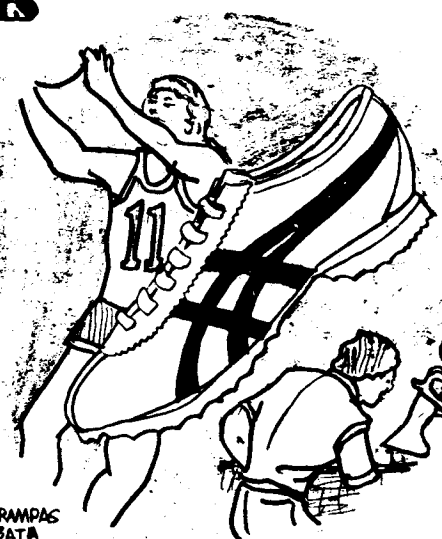
