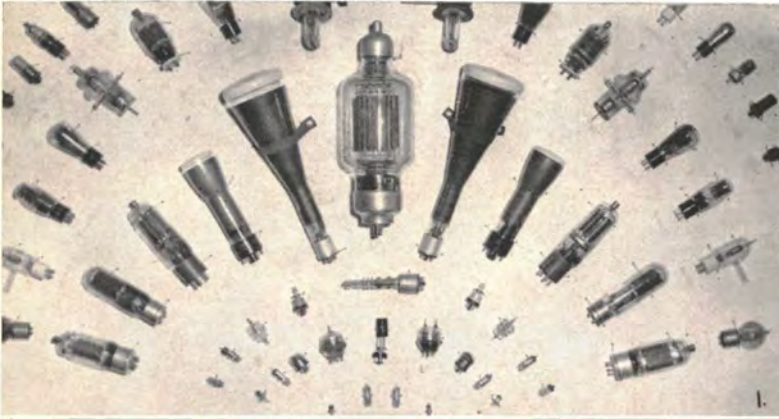

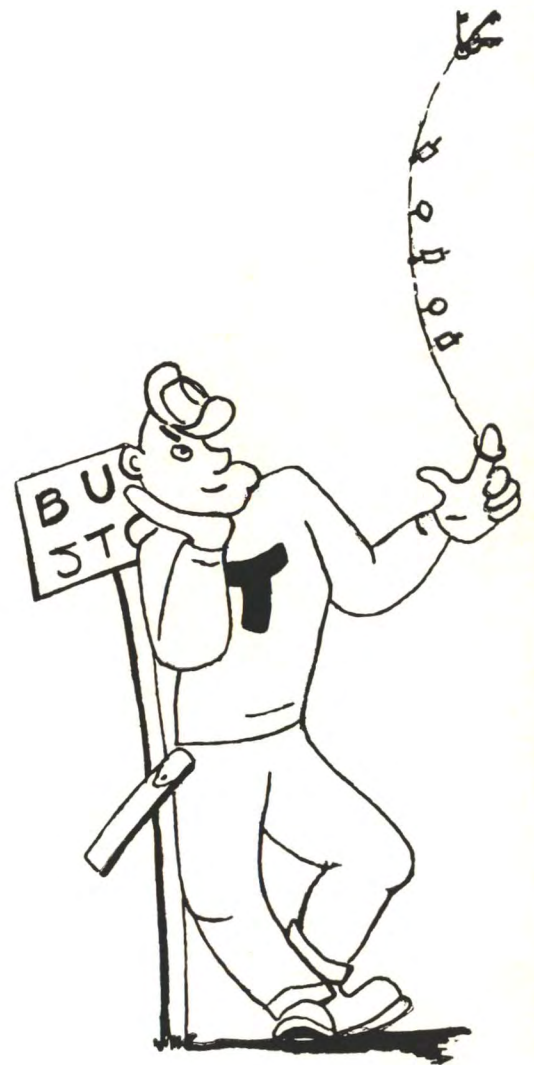

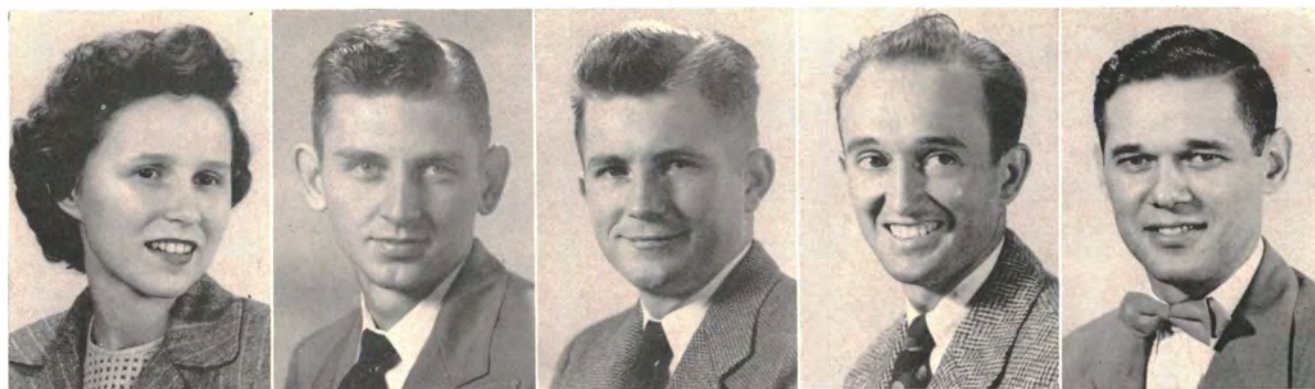
THE TECHNICIAN, student publication of the Southern Technical Institute, first appeared in September of 1948 and has been published monthly since that time.

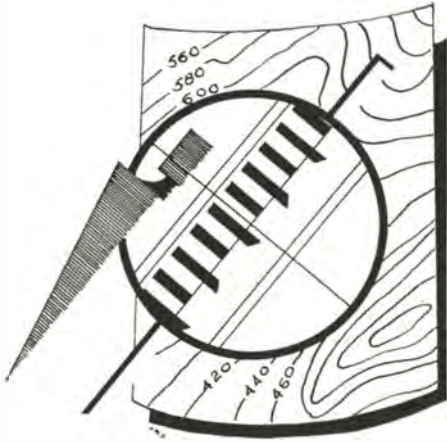

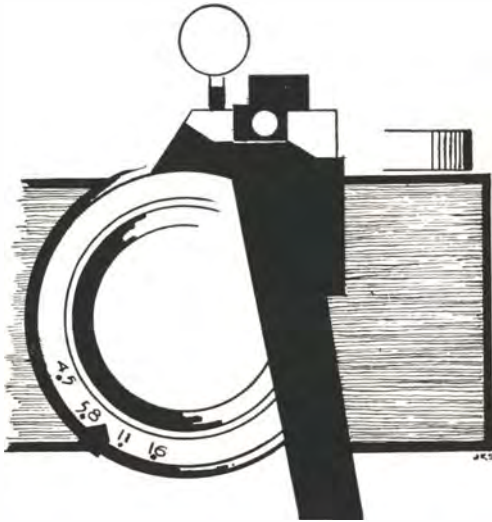
