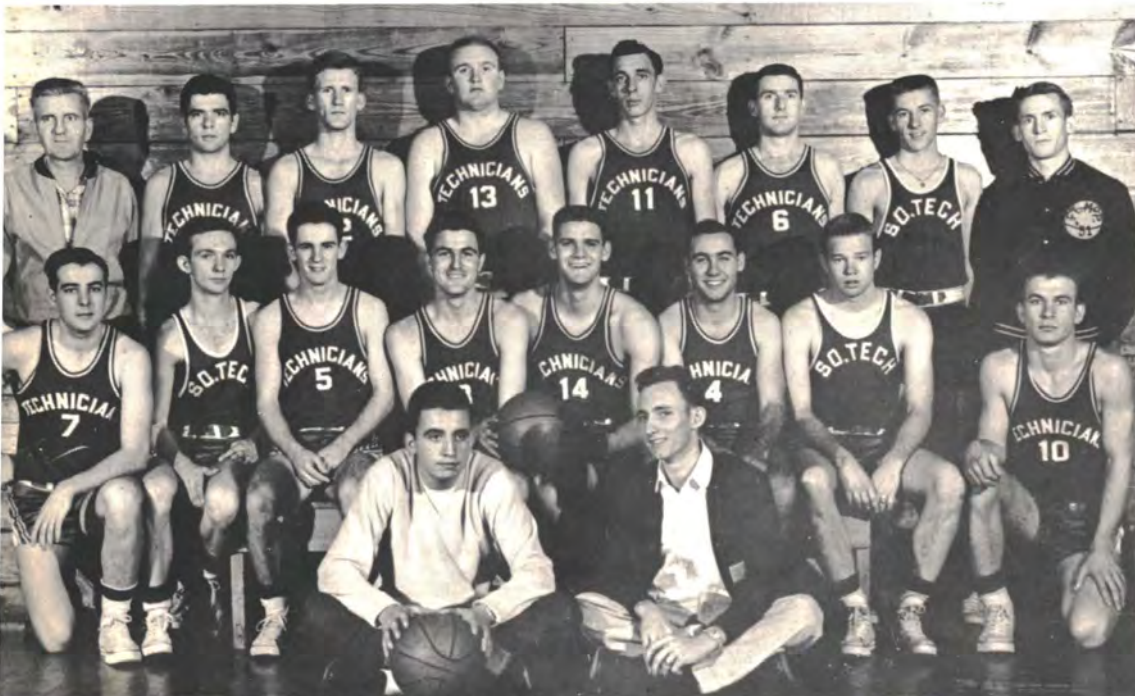
Although hampered by lack of reserve depth, the Southern Tech Green Hornets turned in a commendable performance with 18 wins and 12 losses.

The team started the season with six consecutive victories, showing promises of a championship squad; but after cruising through these early season wins, and after a long holiday lay-off from practice, they met the conference's toughest competition which proved to be too much for the Green Hornets. They then see-sawed their way through the remainder of the season.
