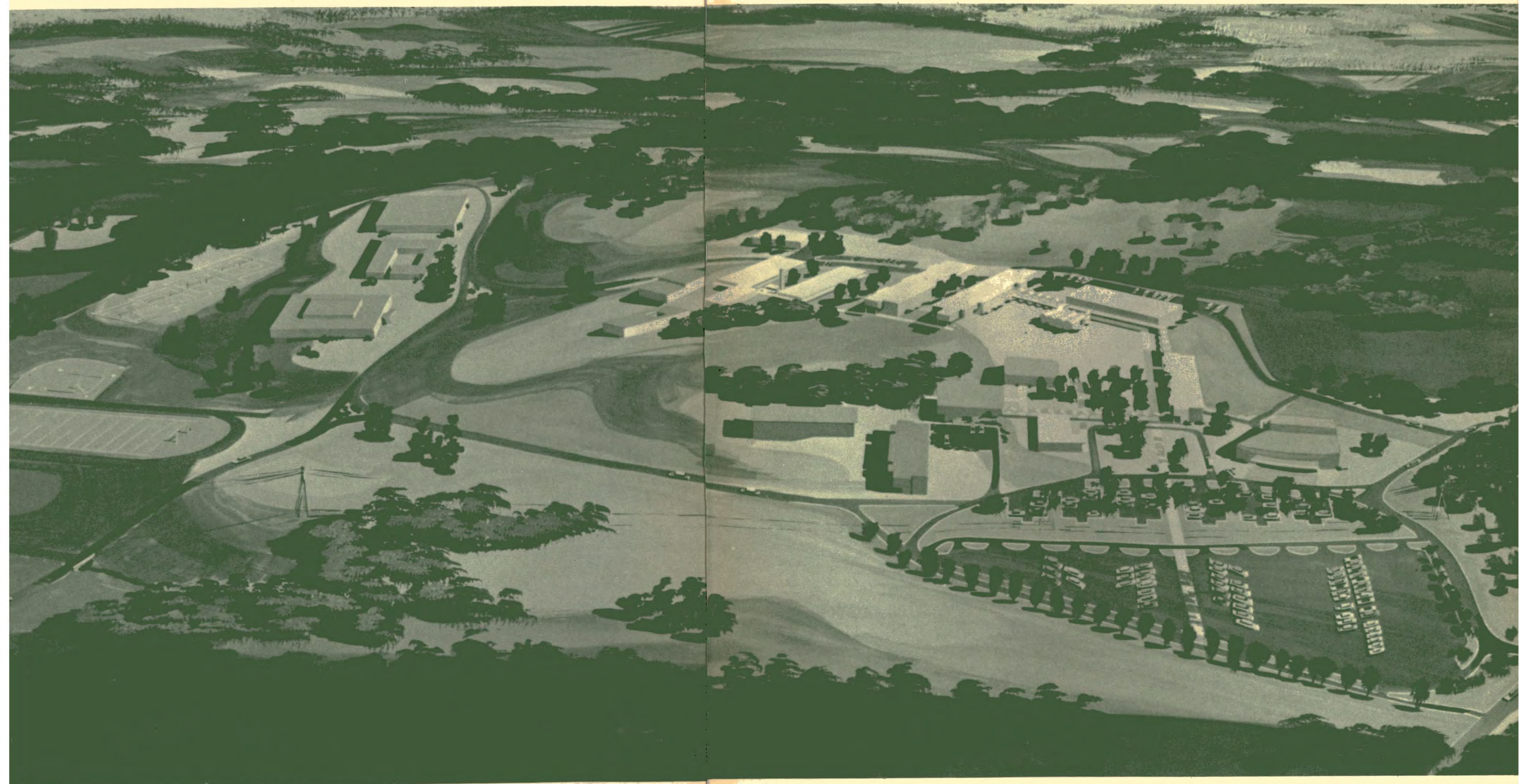

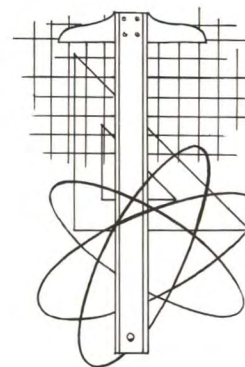

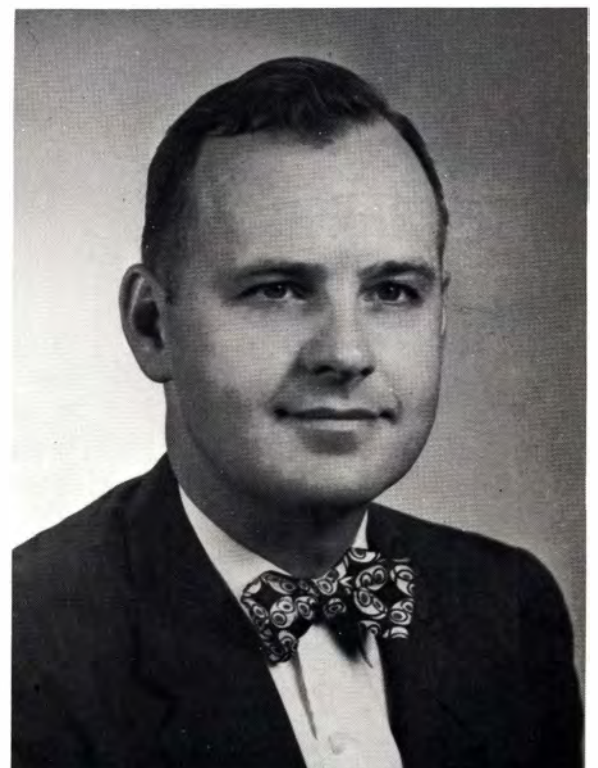
## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

# ENGLISH

Thus, skill in communicating is essential to the technician; on this fact depends the attitude of Southern Tech's English Department.

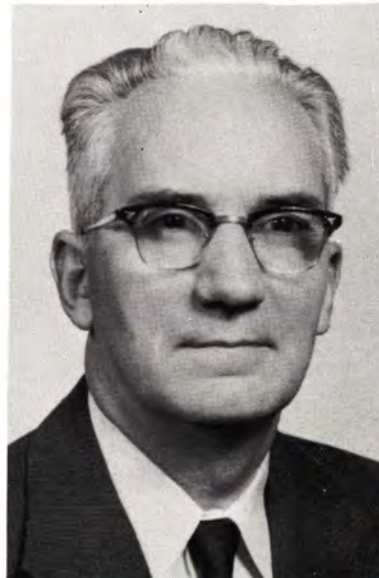

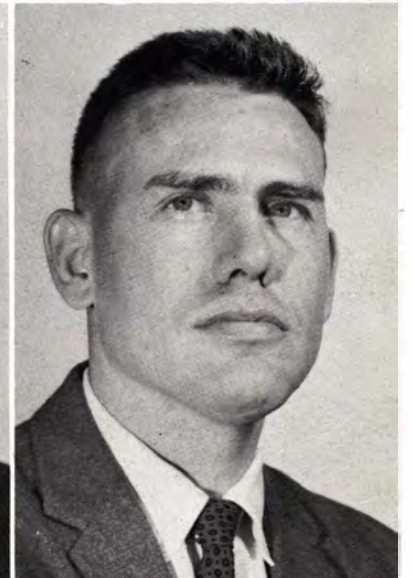
# MATHEMATICS

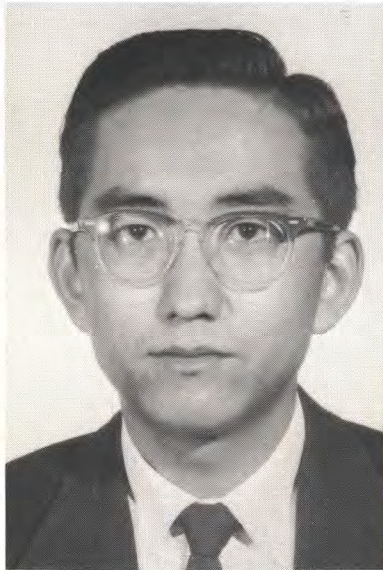

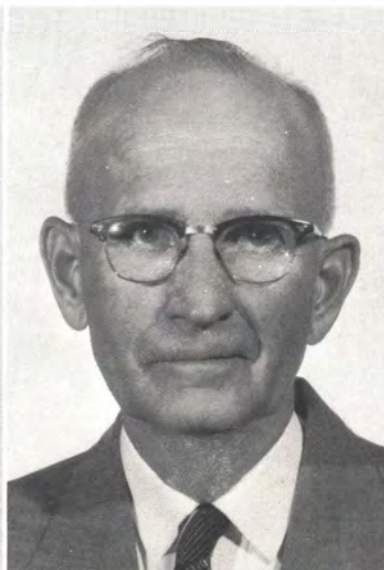

# ELECTRICAL

The Electrical Department offers courses in the three major fields of Electrical Technology. All students in this department receive training in mathematics, physics, English, and electrical-circuit theory. On completion of these courses the student specializes in his option. The Power Option offers training in electrical machinery, power distribution, and illumination, to enable the graduate to fill positions in electrical utilities, and electrical consulting and sales. The Electronics Option gives training in electronics circuits, and microwaves, to prepare the graduate for employment in many electronics industries. The Telephone Option gives training in the principles of telephone systems to enable the graduate to fill important positions in the many telephone companies throughout the country.

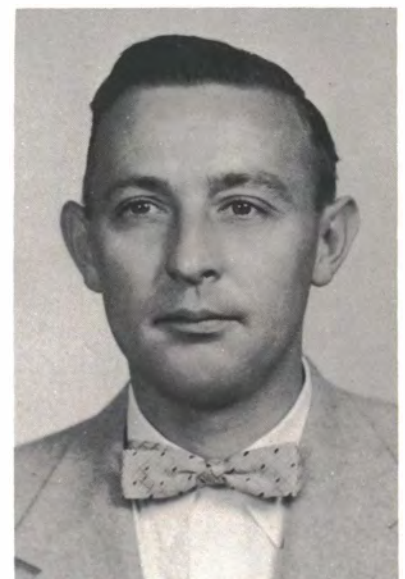

# GAS FUEL

One of Southern Tech's major distinctions is its gas fuel technology department—the only course of its kind in the United States.

The gas industry is one of the top leading industries in the United States and the demand for trained technicians seems almost insatiable; at least, Southern Tech cannot supply 10% of the technicians which the industry needs. This means that gas fuel students have a wide choice of jobs from all sections of the country.

The course encompasses the transmission, distribution, and utilization of natural and liquefied petroleum gas. Of course, basic science subjects, English, management courses, and courses related to the major technical speciality are included. The program is constantly surveyed by leaders in the gas industry to assure that the curriculum is designed to adequately train gas technicians.

## HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING

In the past few years the heating and air conditioning industry has become one of the largest in the country. Already air conditioning is a "must" for homes, offices, hotels, and theaters. New applications of air conditioning and refrigeration theory are announced daily.

The heating and air conditioning course is designed to train technicians to plan, install, operate, and maintain all types of heating, air conditioning and refrigerating equipment. Basic courses in physics, mathematics, mechanical drawing, shop, human relations, technical writing, public speaking, and supervisory training are included.

# INDUSTRIAL

The great value of Industrial Technology graduates to almost any industry is developed through an ever-expanding knowledge of and training in the principles of scientific management, and the ever-changing methods, systems and procedures of industry.

Alert, expanding companies, and those who are creating their place in the forefront of industry need and are employing many of the graduates of the Industrial Technology Department, who have this background.

Industry in Georgia has requested that Southern Tech present a curriculum designed to more specifically qualify graduates for industry's staff and administrative positions. Industrial Technology (Management Option) does this by supplementing industrial know-how with such subjects as Industrial Psychology, Organization and Management, Labor Management and others.

# MECHANICAL

The Mechanical Technology curriculum offers training in three categories:

1. Specialization Courses—Subjects that deal with the mechanical aspects of manufacturing.
2. Personnel and Management Courses—Subjects that deal with the human problems that arise in manufacturing, including time and motion study, supervisory training, etc.
3. Basic Courses—Subjects that are basic in any manufacturing set-up such as English, physics, mathematics, etc.

Classroom theory is correlated with laboratory work in which the student becomes familiar with the basic tools and machines used in the mechanical field. The mechanical curriculum is the least specialized of any of the programs offered at Southern Tech, due to the fact that it is practically impossible to predict the type of position a man will hold when he graduates.

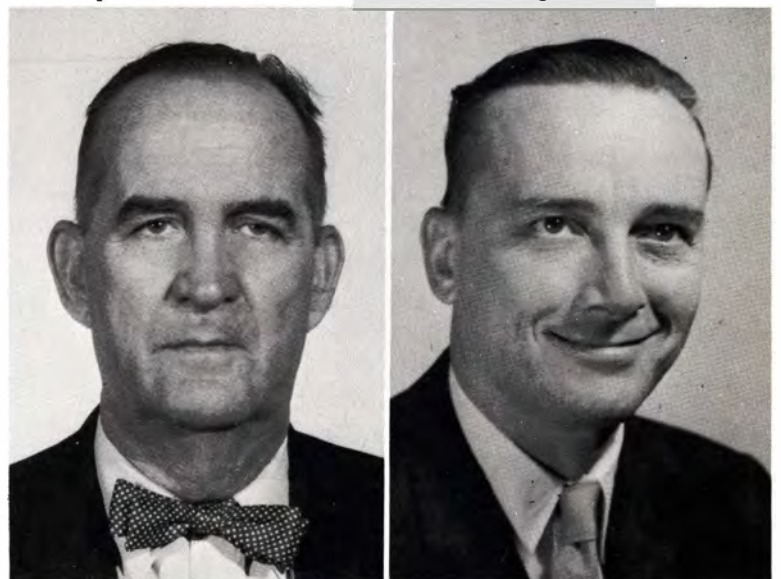
