

















THE BLIZZARD OF 1977






A RENAISSANCE MAN

SPRING RACE

The Annual Spring Bathtub Race is the main event on the Southern Tech campus. Each year thousands of people come to watch twenty or so tubs scream around the 1.1 mile campus track at speeds of sixty to seventy miles an hour. This year twenty-two tubs were entered in the 11th Annual Race. What took only slightly more than an hour from start to finish took hundreds of man-hours to prepare for, additional hours in practice, and the labor of untold numbers of people to co-ordinate, publicize, and direct the race. What the public sees is only the finished product. Very few people know the battles over insurance, the disagreements over rules, the admonitions and fears of the Administration, the allocation of concessions, or the incessant meetings that take place before even one tub is allowed on the track.

It wasn't always so complicated. Certainly the pledges of the fraternities who started it all fifteen years ago had no idea that what had started as a race between two tubs filled with iced beer, pulled by pledges, and navigated on a muddied track, would become an internationally known sporting event. The members of the BRA not only enjoy each race, but during each race they are considering how they can make the next race even better and safer.

Planning for the race is an educational experience in addition to being fun. Consider this problem: How many used tires does it take to cover the perimeter of the inside and outside of the track? Or, how many policemen and track marshals are necessary to insure the safety of 10,000 people? Or, how many hotdogs will a crowd of 10,000 people consume during a three hour period? How many Cokes will a crowd of 10,000 people drink during a three hour period if the temperature is 88 and the humidity is 80%?


The end result is worth all the headaches and heated discussions, the hurt feelings, ruffled egos, and the uncertainty. The high pitched whine of finely tuned engines revving in the pits and the throaty roar of the same engines as they wind through the tortuous track causes the long hours to fade into oblivion.

The Bathtub Race is not only a source of pleasure for the 10,000 or so people who turn out for the excitement every year; the Race has also done much to make Southern Tech known across the country.


