PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH School (1940)

Teachers: Mrs. Eloise Wright And Mrs. Ursula Jenkins

During the earlier years in Marietta and Cobb County, Blacks living in the county were unable to attend school at Marietta city colored school if they had not completed the seventh grade. The county did not have schools set up for colored children at that time. Black Churches throughout the county, started schools within the churches in order to meet the requirements set by the Marietta City School System.

A vacant Building located behind Pleasant Grove Baptist Church was set up and used to accommodate children from that area. It was a one room building with a "Pot Belly Stove" located in the middle of the room. Children were divided into groups and each group was allotted space within that room. Mrs Eloise Wright and Mrs Ursula Jenkins were the teachers.
