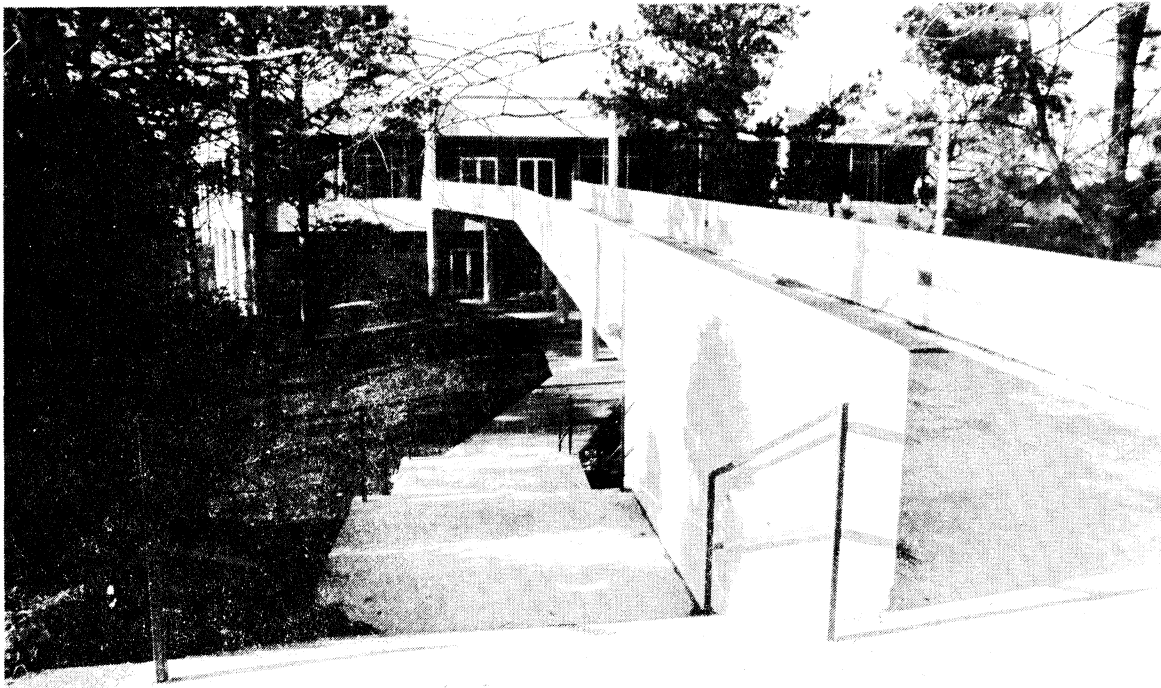

The Student Center opened today, Monday-March 28 at 7:30 a.m. Registration is being held in the Ballroom from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

Several days of activities have been planned to celebrate the opening including a concert by Starbuck, one of the top rising rock groups in the country, Friday, April 1, on the STI campus.

An all day open house is planned for Tuesday with special events including leather work and pottery exhibits and demonstrations, crafts and others. On Tuesday evening, the movie, "Wild Bunch," will be shown at 7 and 9:45 p.m. in the Ballroom. A GRAND OPENING CEREMONY will take place Wednesday at 12 noon with Ribbon Cutting by Southern Tech officials at the official opening of Center Building. Other exhibits, and demonstrations with entertainment of the Student Center Coffee House by Diane Pfiefer from 8 to 10 p.m. On the Thursday schedule are a concert by the Southern Tech Band from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. and the movie, "Let's Scare Jessica to Death," at 10:30 p.m. in the Ballroom. THE STARBUCK CONCERT will be on Friday at 8 p.m. in the STI gym. Tickets are \$2 in advance and \$3 at the door. Tickets are on sale at the Student Center office. Saturday's events will include a pool tournament at 10 a.m. and a foosball tournament at 1 p.m. A Disco Dance will be held Saturday evening at 8 p.m. in the Ballroom.
