

Whoever said variety is the spice of life must have had some missing taste buds. A good liberal arts college provides plenty of spice for its students, but after about three years a student becomes susceptible to Senior Fatigue. Senior Fatigue is a mental condition which affects judgement and perception. The afflicted senior no longer cares about attending class in the morning and stops taking courses that make any sense to healthy individuals. In other words, fatigued seniors don't look at courses on the basis of how useful they are so much as on the basis of how survivable they may be.

For instance, every fatigued senior takes at least one "Easy A" course per guarter. This is usually some lower level class - such as History 111 or 251 - that takes up a free elective and adds to the spice of life. What's spicier than a class where the professor attributes the fall of Rome to either the rise of the middle class or the Treaty of Paris?

The senior, however, must deal with freshman and sophomore students who still raise their hands to ask permission to leave the room. These students also belive in doing homework, since they haven't had enough tests to be able to tell how much information the professor actually believes they will retain. The "Easy A" class is most frequently the one which fatigued seniors give the least amount of attention to.

Also high on the list of priorities is the "Favorite Professor" course. Seniors have to give some thought to finishing out their degrees, so whenever a fatigued senior finds a required course paired with a favorite instructor, the course is automatically on his or her list. This professor is a known quantity. The creature's testing habits and homework assignments have fit so well into the fatigued senior's lifestyle through two 100-level and two 300-level courses that a "Favorite Professor" course can be a real life saver. One third of the quarter is mapped out for the senior before the first day of class.

Every other course in the college curriculum is looked upon disdainfully by the fatigued senior. There is, of course, the "Already Taken" category, meaning that a large number of classes cannot be considered again. This situation depresses the fatigued senior, who can only hope that "Already Taken" also includes the worst possible classes as well, such as "Meat Grinder" and "Purgatory" courses.

The "meat Grinder" is a course where the professor and the materials are known quantities - sometimes with the knowledge coming through rumors, sometimes through hard, bitter experience. "Meat Grinder" courses require total concentration, absolute dedication, and all homework assignments turned in on time. Fatigued seniors dread these courses because they are required and the professor has a well-documented reputation for giving ten page lectures each hour of the class. "Meat Grinder" courses - particularly in History and Math - are responsible for much of college's tough academic reputation.

"Purgatory" courses are well-named. These are not necessarily hard or easy courses, but usually they are required and the professor includes attendance as part of the overall grade. Four cuts is the absolute maximum and often that many are not allowed. A "purgatory" course can ruin a student's day. The knowledge - no matter how vital to a career - is unwanted and should have been offered back in the heyday of the student's sophomore or junior stage in the college life. A good example of a "Purgatory" course might be the last in a two-year sequence of some arcane discipline that really disgusts the senior - such as Math or Computer Science. Or whatever the senior happens to be majoring in.

But life is full of its ups and downs, and it's said that college prepares people to face life, so perhaps it's best that some of the spices offered in college are a little tart or bitter. At least that way the individual will be better prepared for the unwanted things he or she will find beside his or her dreams and goals in the "real world."

Sophomores

The word "Sophomore," comes from two Greek words: sophos (wise) and moros (foolish). It is a very accurate label, for the college sophomore experiences these emotions often during the college year.
