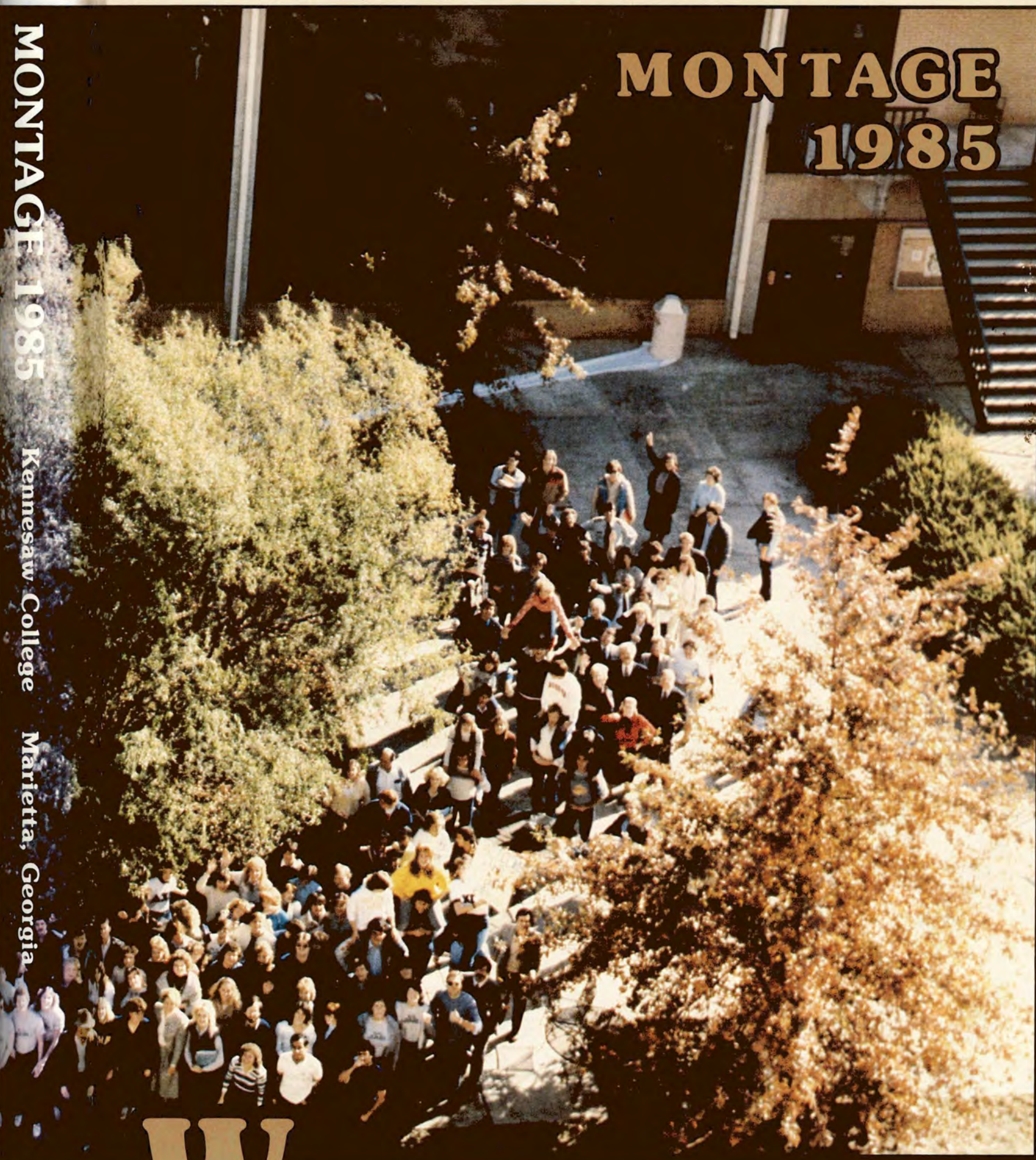

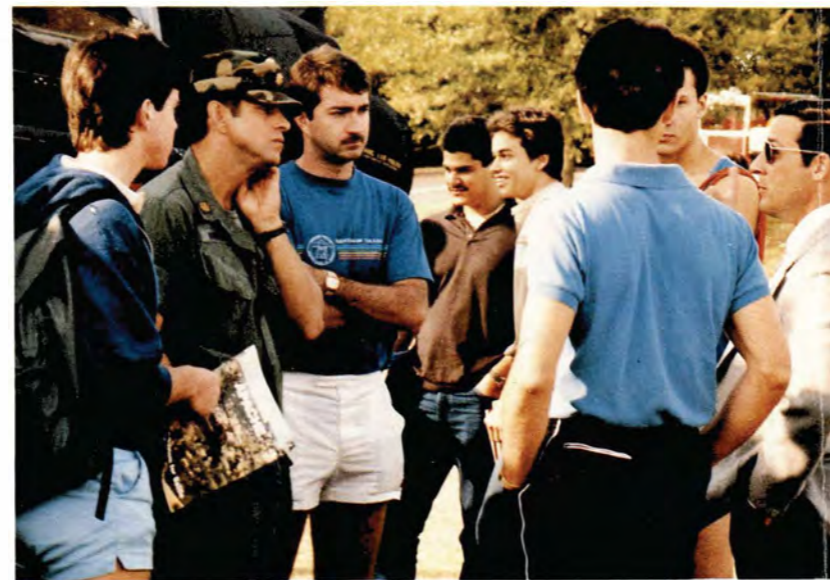

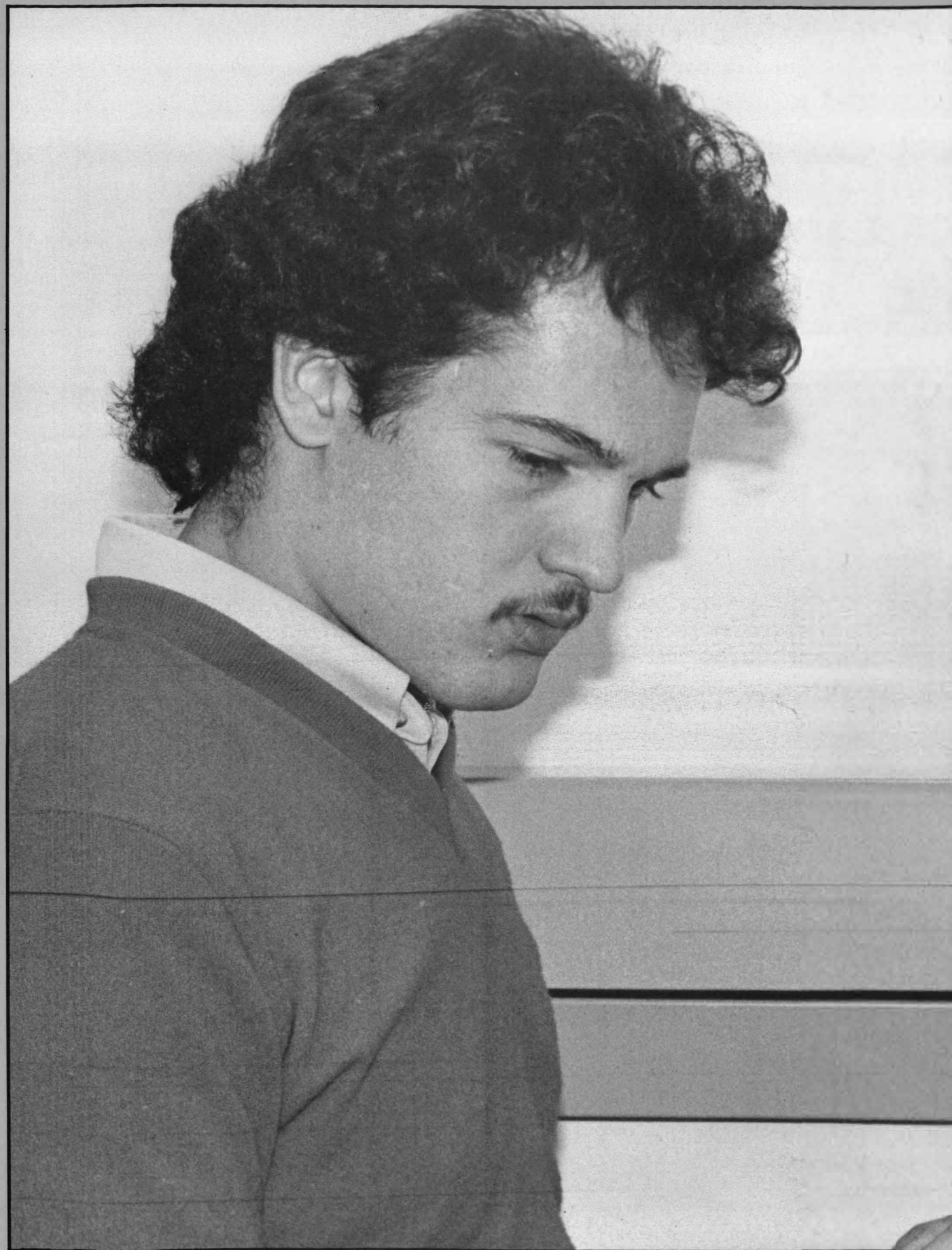

# Registration:

## Is It Worth It?

**Y**ou could not avoid it. Long lines, sore feet, and pushy crowds were all a part of the 1984 Fall Quarter Registration. If you were a junior or senior you may have avoided the line for registration which extended out of the second floor exit, down the steps, and along the sidewalk. No one, however, could avoid standing in the line for the bookstore, which wrapped itself around the first floor of the student center.

With a record enrollment of 5,838 students this fall, many freshmen found it nearly impossible to get an ideal schedule. In fact, some freshmen could not find enough classes to make a full load. One freshman said that he went through five tentative schedules and still was unable to get any of the classes he wanted. He decided to settle for classes which did not count toward his degree. He felt that he was lucky to find enough open classes worth fifteen credit hours.

Others, like sophomore Shannon Brasch, had no problems in getting the classes they wanted. She said that as a freshman she had to stand in line. "I don't think you should have to go

through that every quarter," she said.

As a junior, Debra Jane Luney did not have to wait at all to register for classes, but she said that she spent a lot of time in the bookstore line. "I don't like it, but I figure we are crowded and I know we are. So, I just find someone in line to chat with," said Debra Jane. "I meet a lot of new friends that way."

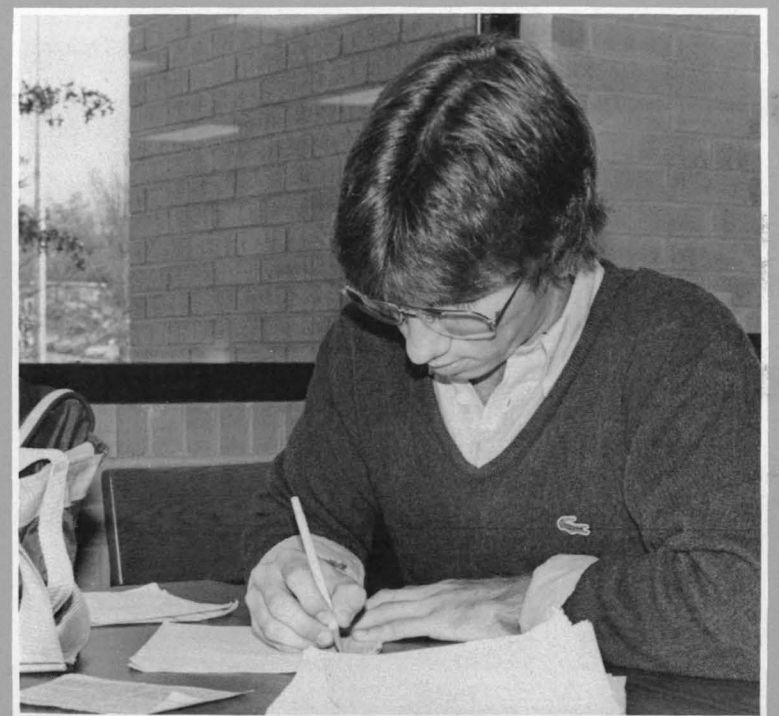
One transfer student laughed and said, "With 6,000 something students, what do you expect?"

Most students said that the hassle was worthwhile. Others just shrugged their shoulders. The 1984 Fall Quarter Registration was just another part of life, something everyone goes through if they want to earn a degree.

Registration for the following quarter was somewhat easier on the feet. The administration offered a pre-registration system to currently enrolled students. About 2,000 students signed up for classes and paid their fees before the Christmas break. Although some were confused at first, most agreed with Rebecca Sams who said, "This is a lot better!"







# The Studier:

Some students tried arriving just as classes let out and then waiting for a convenient space to open up.

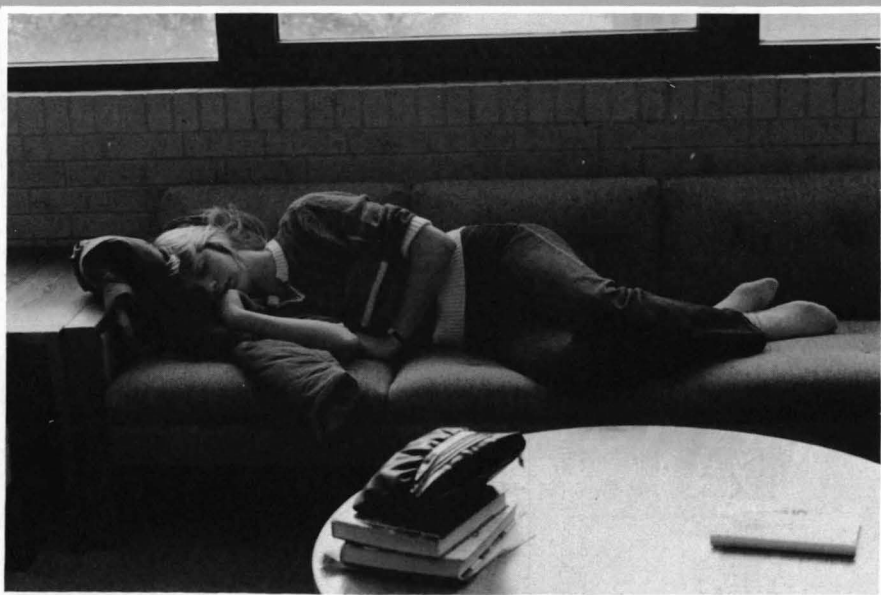
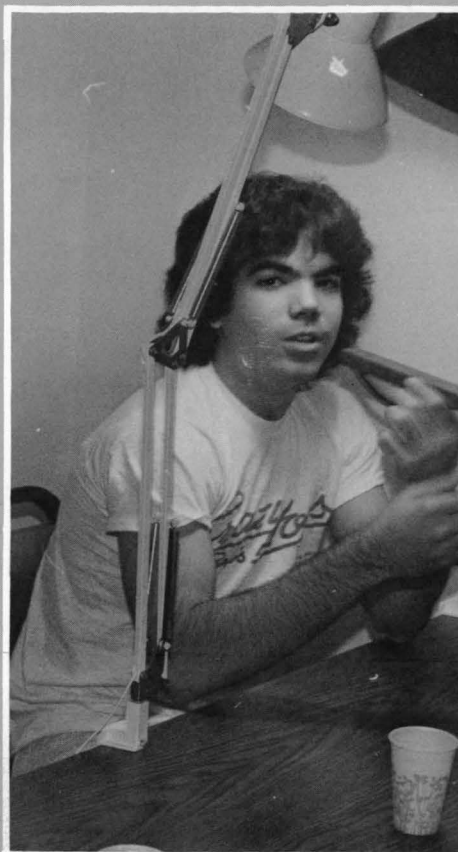
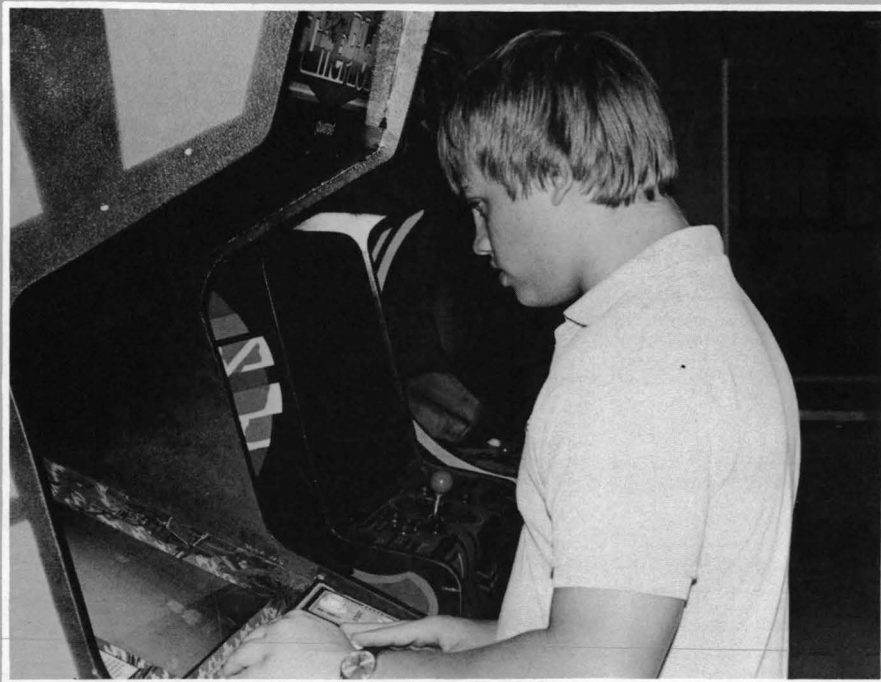
The parking dilemma was brought to a head when parking space, usually

"I like to talk to people in the student center," said Karen Potts, "or play on a piano in the Music Building."

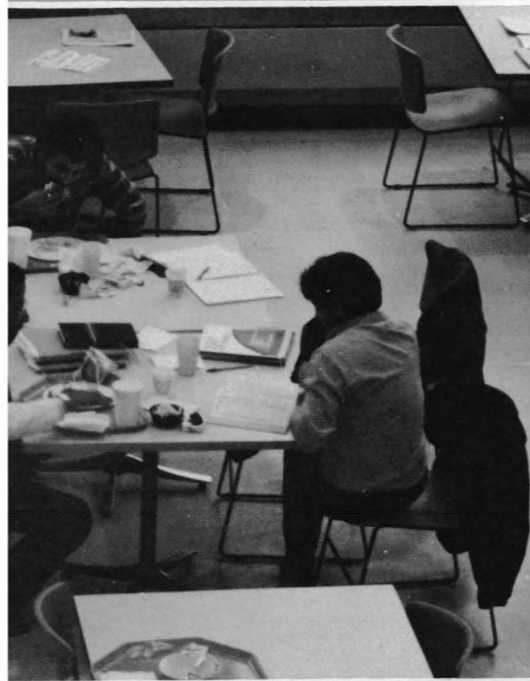
Another favorite past time on campus is sleeping. Students frequent the couches in

The clouds in thousand, Liveries dight.

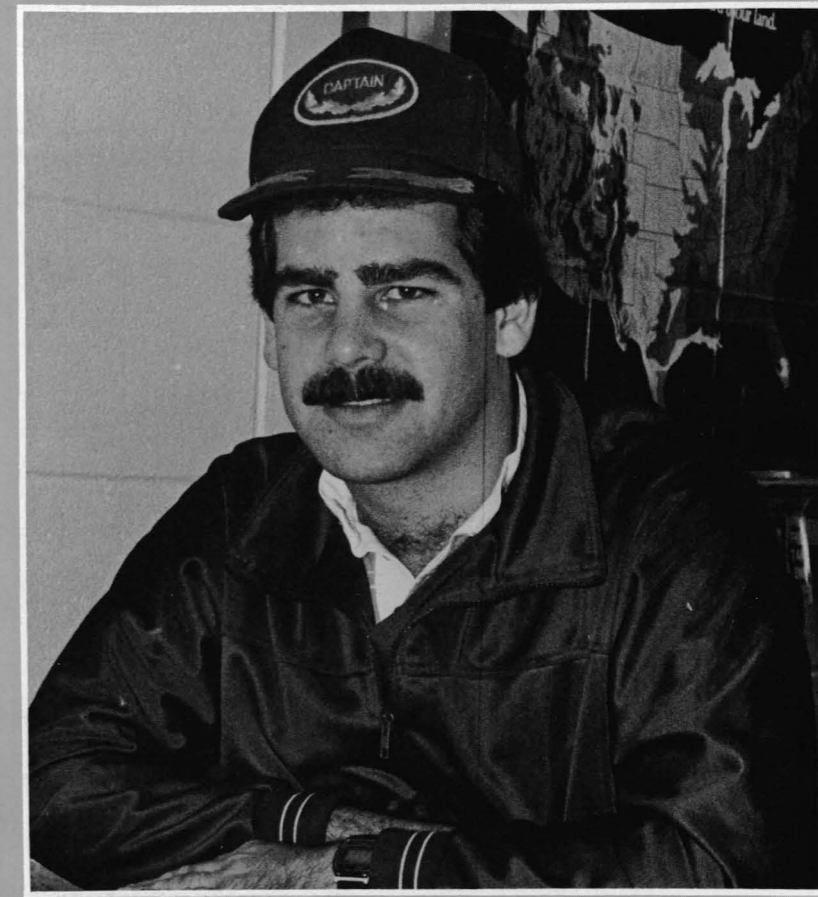
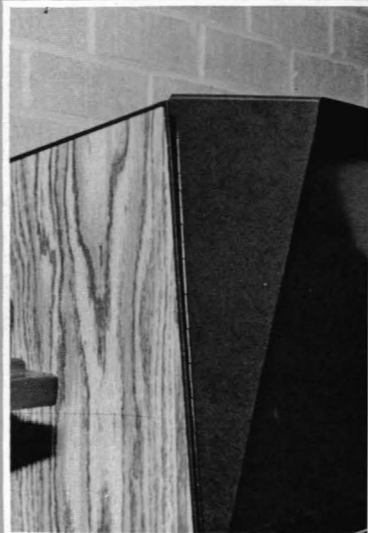
Also like the cheerful man, the day student enjoys the "busy hum of men" in the Student Center (118). The temperament of the day student is one of a hearty love of life and mirth.

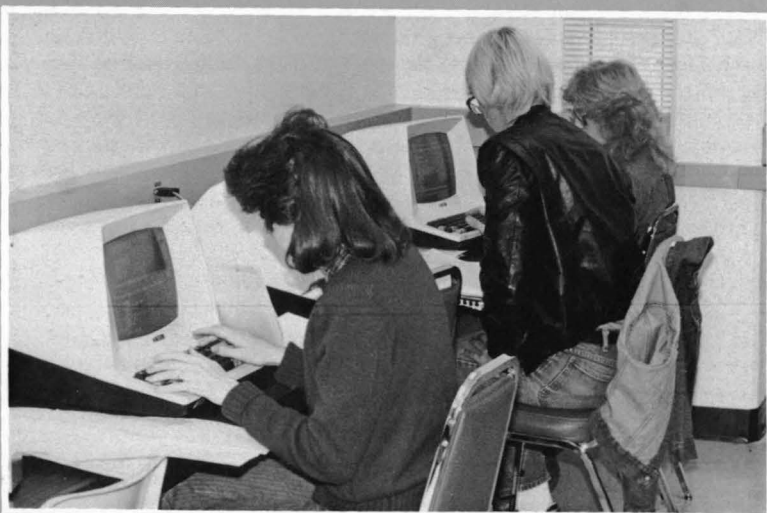
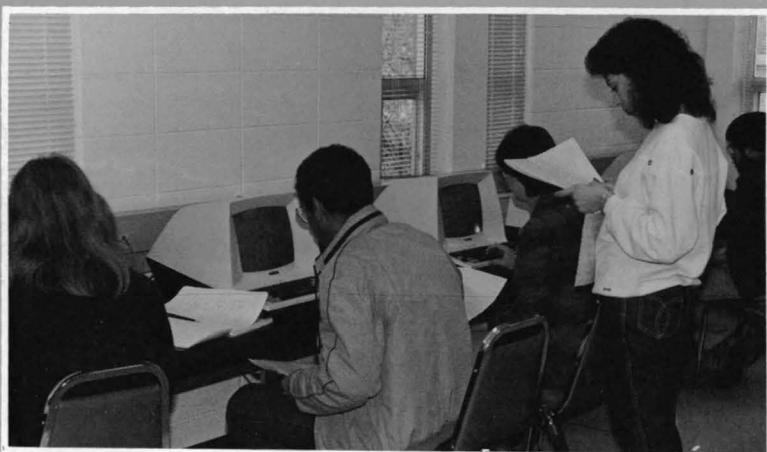
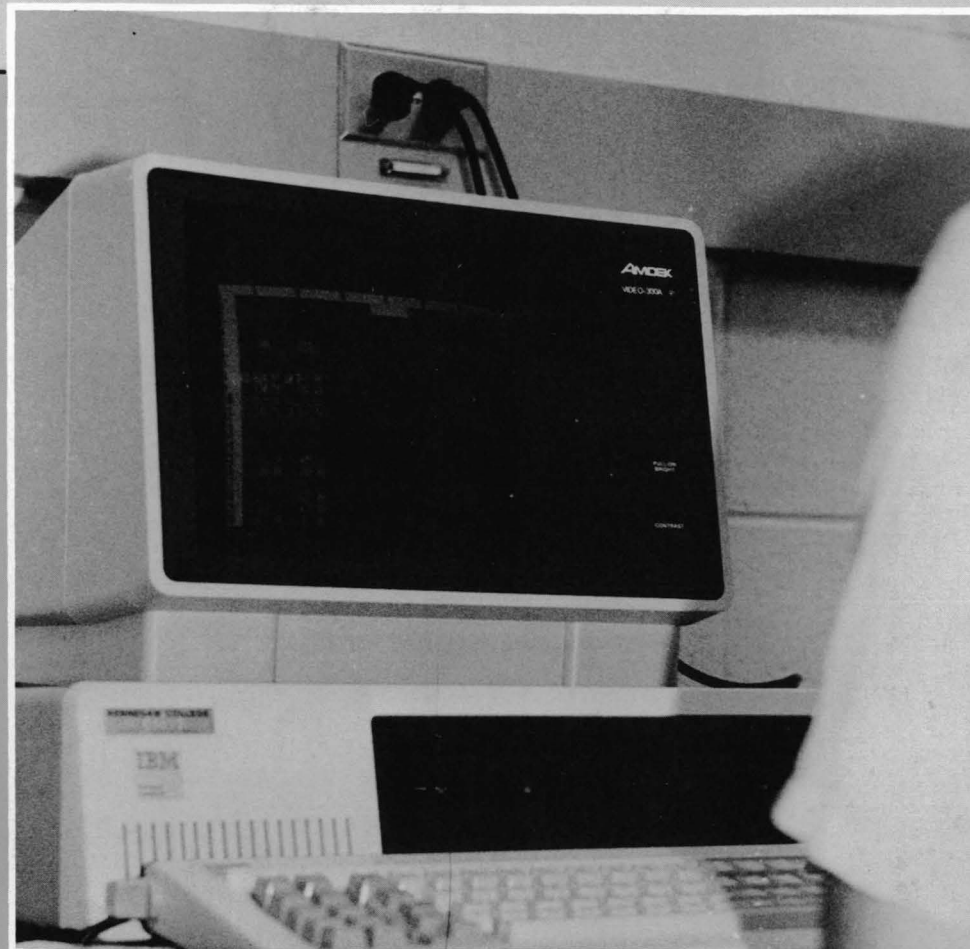
The night student has a temperament similar to John Milton's "Il Penseroso." The contemplative man, "Il Penseroso," woos to

## A Basic Tool:

Growing up in the computer age

Computers affect just about every aspect of life. This broad influence extends to student life. Dr. Steven E. Scherer, Chair of the Department of Math and Computer Science and Academic and Computer Services Coordinator, said that most of the programs of study on campus either require or recommend at least one computer science course and that other programs of study use the on campus computer as a learning tool. The School of Education, he explained, "builds it into a mathematics course." Some English 101 classes use "class time in the micro lab to write their papers," he said, "and are looking to expand the use of computers." German classes use the computer for assisting instruction. "The Music Department now

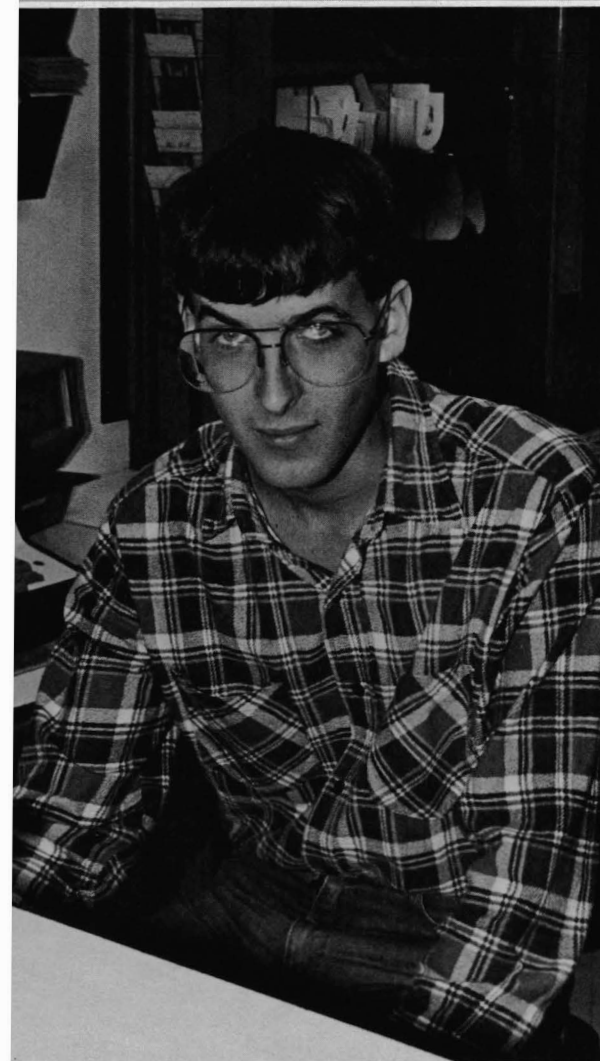
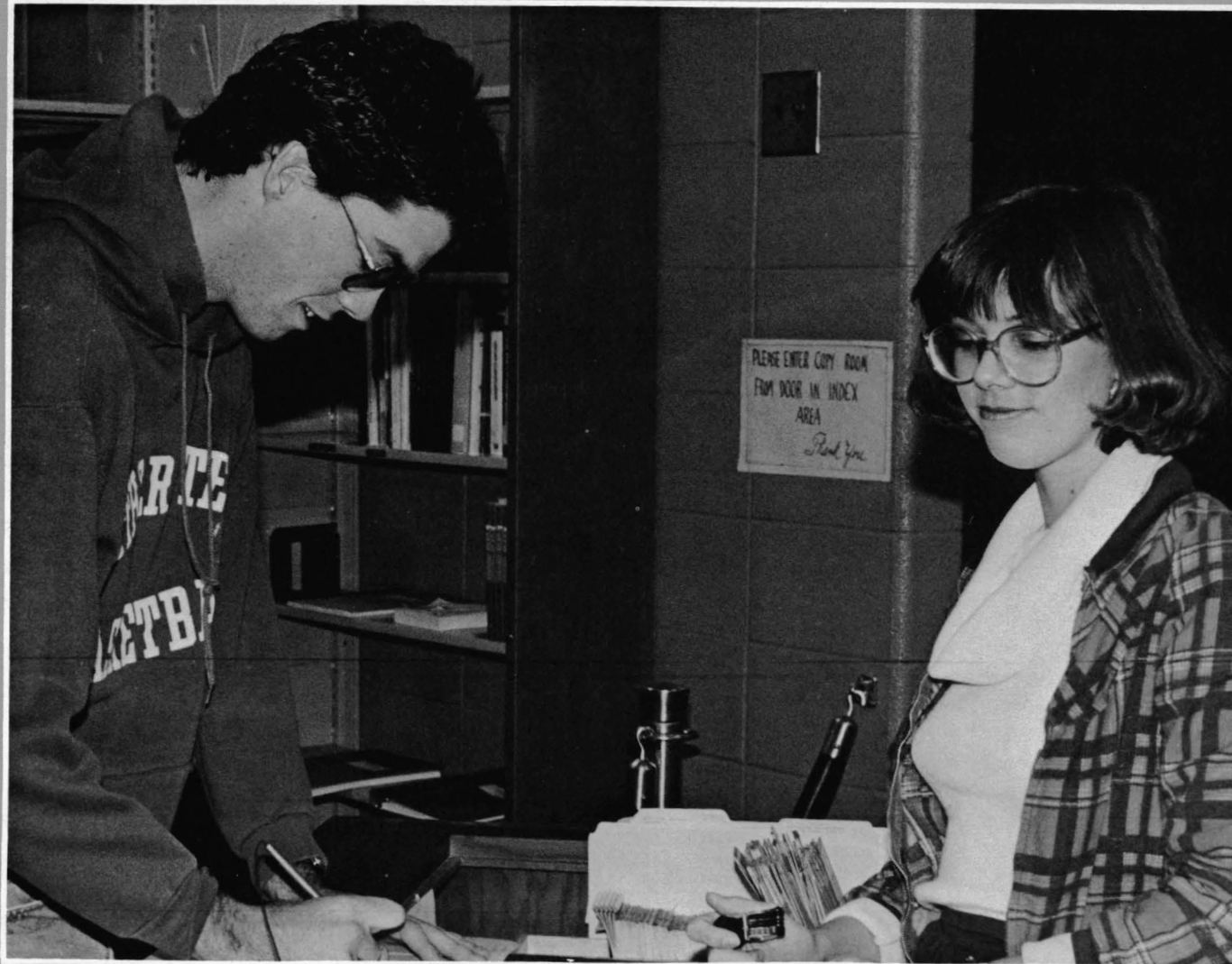
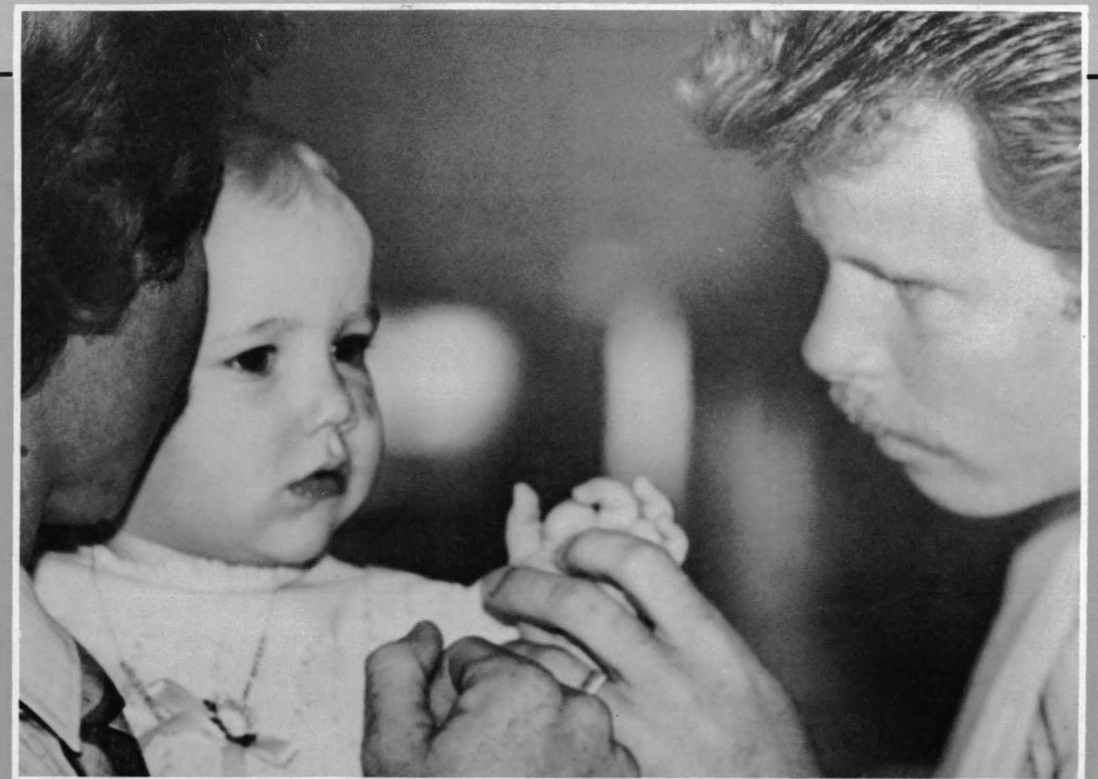
has two," he said, "and soon will have a third for music theory. The computers have synthesizers with them so students can play music on them, can actually write out music, and can have a computer printout of their work." Dr. Scherer also said "P.E. has a computer on order for use with some of their classes to simulate motion, showing how things move." The School of Natural Science and Allied Health uses the campus computer. "In Biology," he said, "students can simulate environmental problems. Patty Regio is using it to plot graphs in Chemistry." The Institute for Public and Social Services used the computer to do an analysis of the 1984 election in Cobb County. Other programs of study use the computer as well.

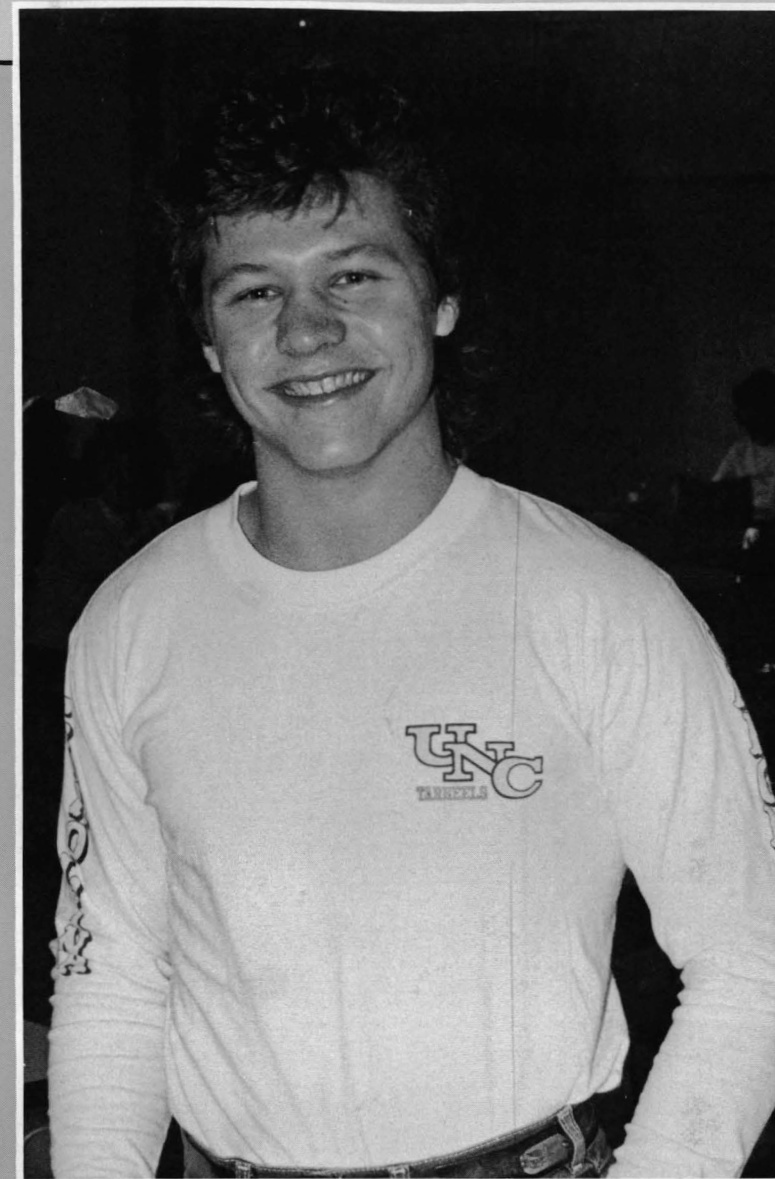
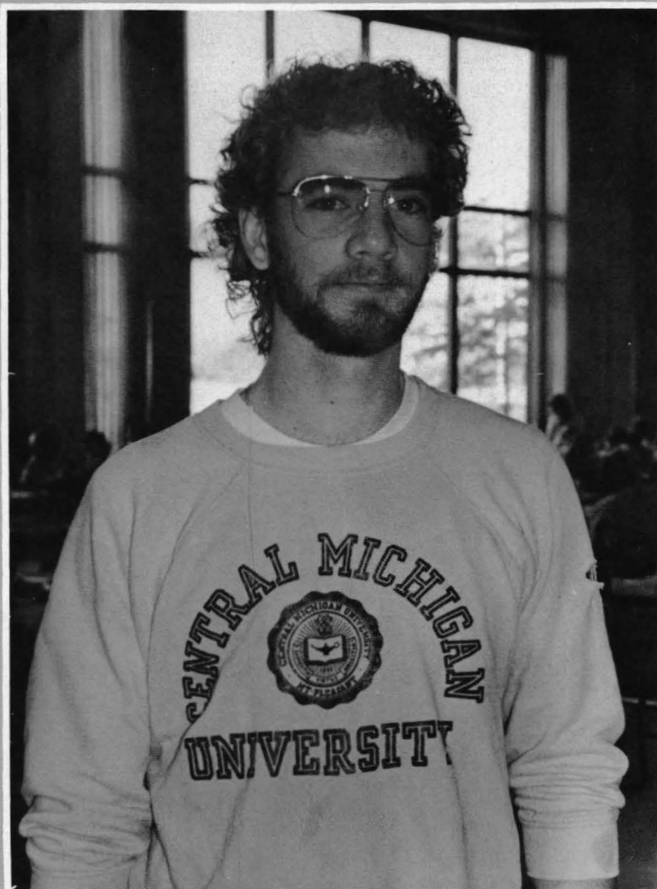
# Nine To Five:

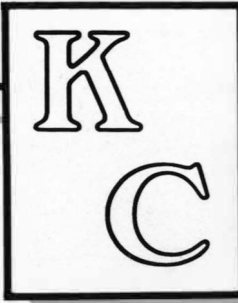

# Sigma Tau Delta

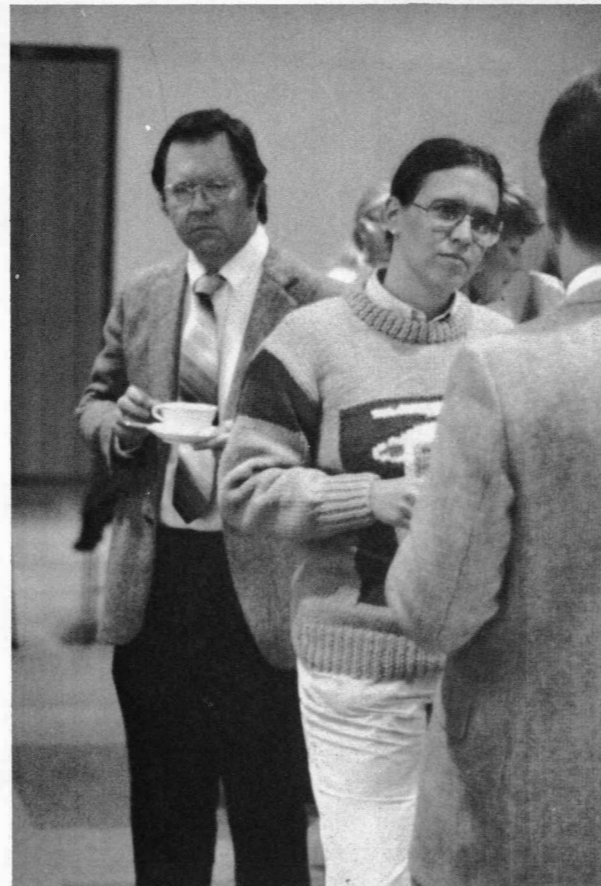

**CLASSES**



Whoever said variety is the spice of life must have had some missing taste buds. A good liberal arts college provides plenty of spice for its students, but after about three years a student becomes susceptible to Senior Fatigue. Senior Fatigue is a mental condition which affects judgment and perception. The afflicted senior no longer cares about attending class in the morning and stops taking courses that make any sense to healthy individuals. In other words, fatigued seniors don't look at courses on the basis of how useful they are so much as on the basis of how survivable they may be.

For instance, every fatigued senior takes at least one "Easy A" course per quarter. This is usually some lower level class — such as History 111 or 251 — that takes up a free elective and adds to the spice of life. What's spicier than a class where the professor attributes the fall of Rome to either the rise of the middle class or the Treaty of Paris?

The senior, however, must deal with freshman and sophomore students who still raise their hands to ask permission to leave the room. These students also believe in doing homework, since they haven't had enough tests to be able to tell how much information the professor actually believes they will retain. The "Easy A" class is most frequently the one which fatigued seniors give the least amount of attention to.

Also high on the list of priorities is the "Favorite Professor" course. Seniors have to give some thought to finishing out their degrees, so whenever a fatigued senior finds a required course paired with a favorite instructor, the course is automatically on his or her list. This professor is a known quantity. The creature's testing habits and homework assignments have fit so well into the fatigued senior's lifestyle through two 100-level and two 300-level courses that a "Favorite Professor" course can be a real life saver. One third of the quarter is mapped out for the senior before the first day of class.

Every other course in the college curriculum is looked upon disdainfully by the fatigued senior. There is, of course, the "Already Taken" category, meaning that a large number of classes cannot be considered again. This situation depresses the fatigued senior, who can only hope that "Already Taken" also includes the worst possible classes as well, such as "Meat Grinder" and "Purgatory" courses.

The "meat Grinder" is a course where the professor and the materials are known quantities — sometimes with the knowledge coming through rumors, sometimes through hard, bitter experience. "Meat Grinder" courses require total concentration, absolute dedication, and all homework assignments turned in on time. Fatigued seniors dread these courses because they are required and the professor has a well-documented reputation for giving ten-page lectures each hour of the class. "Meat Grinder" courses — particularly in History and Math — are responsible for much of college's tough academic reputation.

"Purgatory" courses are well-named. These are not necessarily hard or easy courses, but usually they are required and the professor includes attendance as part of the overall grade. Four cuts is the absolute maximum and often that many are not allowed. A "purgatory" course can ruin a student's day. The knowledge — no matter how vital to a career — is unwanted and should have been offered back in the heyday of the student's sophomore or junior stage in the college life. A good example of a "Purgatory" course might be the last in a two-year sequence of some arcane discipline that really disgusts the senior — such as Math or Computer Science. Or whatever the senior happens to be majoring in.

But life is full of its ups and downs, and it's said that college prepares people to face life, so perhaps it's best that some of the spices offered in college are a little tart or bitter. At least that way the individual will be better prepared for the unwanted things he or she will find beside his or her dreams and goals in the "real world."
