


### THE NAIA

The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) is a completely autonomous association which administers programs leading to national championships in 15 events for more than 500 fully-accredited four-year colleges and universities in all 50 states and Canada.

Established in 1940 as the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball the NAIB evolved from the institution of a "National Small College Basketball Tournament" which was inaugurated in 1937. In 1952, the NAIB

## **AIMING HIGH**



Before a frenzied crowd at the NAIA District 25 finals in Milledgeville last March, the second-seeded Hornets fell 38-36 to number one seed Georgia College, ending Tech's dream of reaching the NAIA's round of 32 in the National Championship Tournament at Kemper Arena in Kansas City, Mo.

Still, in what veteran coach George Perides saw as a rebuilding season, the Hornets won 20-plus games for the 10th time in the past 11 years. And Tech (22-11), with only one starter from 1987's 27-7 district championship team, upset pre-season predictions by reaching the district finals for the ninth time in the past 11 seasons.

To reach the finals, the Hornets defeated seventh-seeded Kennesaw College 58-51 in the opening round at Southern Tech and went into overtime to beat second-round foe North Georgia 67-62.

Gone are all-district/all-conference forward Terry Givens, who set school season (609 pts., 18.45 ppg) and individual game (37 pts. vs. Knoxville College 2/27/88) scoring records last year, and leading rebounder Bobby Hines. But Tech returns five players who saw significant playing time in 1987-88, including starting senior guards John "Chris" Boulware at the point and John Molden at the two guard. Also back is senior forward Rodney Armstrong, junior post man Darren Holley and sophomore guard Maurice Charlton, a member of the GIAC All-Freshman team last year.

In addition, Perides will have eight newcomers to blend in with the returnees. Junior-college transfers Cordell Benton and Earl Johnson will share the pivot with Holley. Chuck Johnson, a transfer from GMC, where he was voted Georgia's co-JUCO Player of the Year, can play either guard or forward, and quick Joe Brown will be counted upon to provide depth at guard, as will redshirt freshman Adolphus Harper.

Guard/forward Derrick Howard, 6-6 scrapper Scott Edwards and redshirt junior Rufus Kay all appear capable of helping, continuing the Tech tradition under Perides of being one of the district's deepest squads, if not always the most talented.

Bright spots last year included Tech's 17-1 record in the Hornets' Nest, which continues to be a Death Valley for opposing teams. An addition to the Tech coaching staff is veteran Hamp Alexander, who brings a wealth of experience in NAIA District 25 from his previous 16 years as head basketball coach and baseball coach at Shorter College in Rome.

A tough schedule awaits, with pre-Christmas stops at the Birmingham Southern (Nov. 18-19) and Washburn (Kan.) University (Dec. 15-17) tournaments, where Tech will play some of the NAIA's top squads. The Hornets will host the Hornet Classic Tournament December 2 and 3. Their 18-game district schedule begins January 3 against Piedmont College (away) and includes home games with Tech's ever-growing list of archrivals: North Georgia (Jan. 7), Kennesaw (Jan. 16), Georgia College (Jan. 21) and Georgia Southwestern (Jan. 30).


Head Coach George Perides enters his thirteenth season of leading the Runnin' Hornets with an impressive track record. In Perides twelve seasons at Southern Tech, the Hornets have compiled a 274-110 record and have captured the NAIA District title for a record five straight years from 1978-1982 and again in 1987. In ten of his last eleven seasons, his teams have won at least 20 games.

George Perides came to Southern Tech from small Palm Beach, Atlantic College in West Palm Beach, Florida, His team made one trip to Kansas City and posted a 82-43 mark over four seasons.

Hamp Alexander, who was Head Coach at Shorter for sixteen years, joined the staff this year as an assistant. Also, Chris Carter, a former player who helped take the Hornets to the Nationals in 1987 and District final in 1988, is assisting with the coaching.


