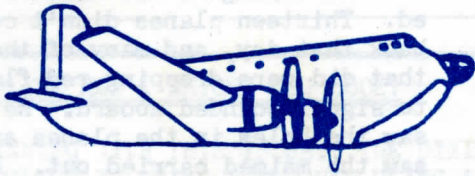

An Inventory Management Superintendent in the 918th Supply Squadron, Thomas was selected for the first quarter of 1967 from a list of nominees submitted by various units in the organization.

Among the prizes he will receive in honor of his selection are:
